- A PDF copy of a letter of reference provided by a staff member at your school; and
- A PDF copy of your acceptance to the post-secondary facility you will attend in September.
(If not available at time of application, must be submitted separately by 1 June.)

NOTES FOR COMPLETING THE APPLICATION:

1. This application is for Cadets who are completing, or have completed, Grade 12 and are continuing their education at a post-secondary institution in the Fall. Applicants must not have received a Hubbell Award in previous years.
